

RESOLUTION NO. 19-63

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LOW BID OF MCMASTER LAWN & PEST SERVICES, LLC TO PROVIDE LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR THE POLICE, FIRE AND OTHER FACILITIES IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$186,375.25 FOR A TERM OF THREE-YEARS WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW THREE ONE-YEAR TERMS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE GENERAL SERVICES CONTRACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BID DOCUMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE CITY'S RENEWAL OPTIONS, SUBJECT TO BUDGETING AND APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, bids for the Landscape Maintenance for Police, Fire, and other facilities were duly called for and advertised; and

WHEREAS, bid opening was on January 10, 2019, the Bid Tabulation being attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Director recommends acceptance of the bid submitted by McMaster Lawn & Pest Services, LLC in an annual amount of \$186,375.25 and the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The City Commission finds that the lowest and best bid submitted by a responsive bidder is the following:


SECTION 2. The bid approved in Section 1 above is hereby accepted subject to the terms and conditions of the bid documents.
