

RESOLUTION NO. 18-133

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF SANDERSON CONCRETE CONSTRUCTION INC., TO PROVIDE AS-NEEDED CONCRETE DELIVERY AND PLACEMENT SERVICES FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS WITH OPTIONS TO RENEW FOR THREE ONE-YEAR TERMS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE TERM CONSTRUCTION SERVICES CONTRACT NO. 0118-0230; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPEND UP TO \$48,683.47 FOR SERVICES UNDER THE CONTRACT FOR THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE RENEWAL OPTIONS AND EXPEND SUCH SUMS DURING RENEWAL TERMS AS ARE BUDGETED AND APPROPRIATED; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals for as-needed concrete delivery and placement services; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or his designee has reviewed proposals submitted for the services; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Public Works Director recommends acceptance of the proposal submitted by Sanderson Concrete Construction, Inc., for as-needed concrete delivery and placement services; and

WHEREAS, anticipated costs for services under the proposal for the remainder of FY 2017-2018 do not exceed \$48,683.47; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by Sanderson Concrete Construction, Inc., for as-needed concrete delivery and placement services for a two year term with options to renew for three one-year terms, with the scope of services and compensation to be negotiated and mutually agreed upon for each project prior to authorization by the City, is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Contract Delivery & Placement Term Contract No. 0118-0230 with Sanderson Concrete Construction, Inc. A copy of the Contract in substantially final form is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to exercise the renewal options, and to expend such sums during the renewal terms as are budgeted and appropriated.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
