TASK ORDER #12

THIS TASK ORDER IS ISSUED PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES DATED MAY 7, 2019 AND CONTRACT RENEWAL DATED MAY 7, 2023, BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF OKALOOSA, FLORIDA, AND GULF COAST UNDERGROUND, LLC. AS WELL AS THE ARPA AGREEMENT NO. SLT0786 BETWEEN OKALOOSA COUNTY AND THE U.S. TREASURY, WHICH IS INCORPORATED HEREIN BY THIS REFERENCE.

Scope of Task Order (#12) Services for Gravity Sewer Rehab Maintenance Contract

Article A. Purpose:

The purpose of this Task Order is to authorize and direct CONTRACTOR (Gulf Coast Underground) to proceed with construction services for assisting the Okaloosa County Water and Sewer Department (COUNTY) to rehabilitate gravity sewer infrastructure. All work completed under this task order involving the American Rescue Plan Act, Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund, shall comply with the County's grant agreement with the U.S. Treasury agreement No. SLT-0786. The activities that are included are described in "Article B. Scope of Services."

Article B. Scope of Services:

The professional construction services that CONTRACTOR agrees to furnish additional services for the rehabilitation of gravity sewer infrastructure primarily in Ocean City, Wright, and Beachview service areas to include CIPP lining, manhole lining, wet well lining, lateral lining, traffic control, bypass pumping, and any other related services covered in the referenced agreement.

Article C. Compensation Provisions:

As compensation for providing the services described within this Task Order, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR in accordance with Contract Renewal (dated May 7, 2023) and the May 7, 2019 Agreement, based on the CONTRACTOR's Bid Item Schedule (Items 1-155), as adjusted in the Contract Renewal for the actual items performed/installed on the Project. The budget ceiling for this Task Order is \$1,925,000.00

The COUNTY shall pay the CONTRACTOR in installments calculated based upon the items of work completed as agreed upon by the COUNTY and CONTRACTOR and submitted on the CONTRACTOR'S Invoice/Pay Estimate Report.



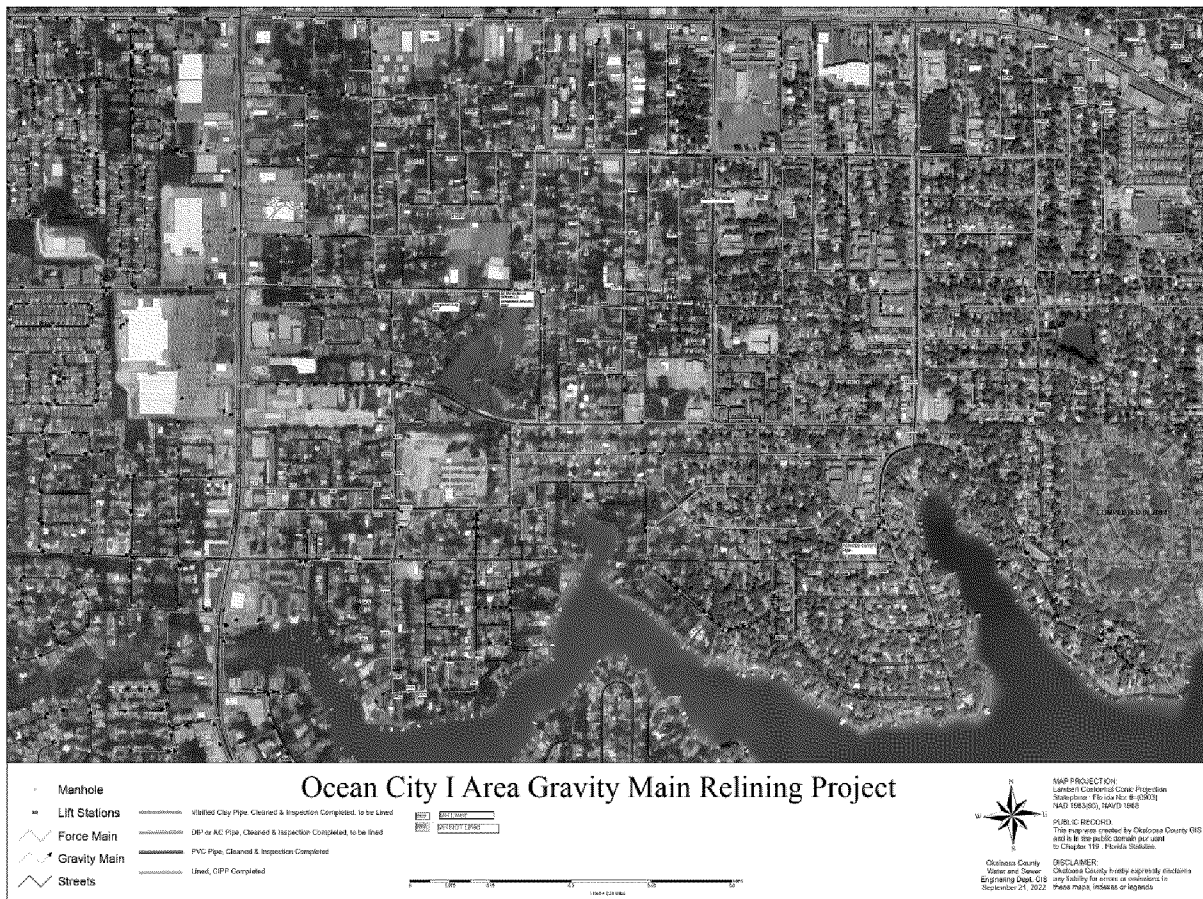

FY 2023-2024 GCUC Task Order #12 (\$1,925,000)

- Ocean City, Fort Walton Beach –additional sections of 8” and 10” vitrified clay pipe gravity sewer to be cleaned, inspected and lined with cured in place piping in one of OCWS’ oldest sewer service areas. This portion of work extends from the previously cleaned, inspected and lined sewer piping, 17.2 miles have previously been completed. Approximately 12,000 linear feet (2.3 miles) of piping are to be rehabilitated in this area. In addition, approximately 300 manholes will be rehabilitated during this fiscal year.



- W. Sunset & Gap Creek Area, Fort Walton Beach—5,500 linear feet (1.1 miles) of 8" VC pipe gravity sewer to be cleaned, inspected and lined with cured-in-place piping. This area is immediately adjacent to Gap Creek and includes three list stations (Beal St, W Sunset and Gap Creek) that have recently seen high-flow levels, an indication of inflow and infiltration during heavy rain storms.



- Beachview Dr. Area, Fort Walton Beach – 7,000 feet (1.33 miles) of 8” and 10” VC pipe gravity sewer to be cleaned, inspected and lined with cured in place piping in one of OCWS’ oldest sewer service areas. The Beachview Drive area is immediately adjacent to Garnier’s Beach Park (Okaloosa County Park) on Choctawhatchee Bay.

STATEMENT OF ISSUE: Okaloosa County Water & Sewer (OCWS) staff is requesting Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approval on Task Order 12 with Gulf Coast Underground, LLC (GCU), for a total cost not to exceed \$1,925,000.00. The scope of work for Task Order 12 will include the rehabilitation of gravity sewer lines by way of lining vitrified clay pipe and aging manholes in the Ocean City/Wright Area. More specifically, the scope will primarily be the areas remaining south of Racetrack Rd, Beal Street, West Sunset Blvd., and the incoming piping to the Gap Creek Lift Station and Beachview Drive Lift Station. Other rehabilitation items that arise with an immediate need for repair/rehabilitation will also be covered under this task order, as needed. Task Order 12 is attached for your review and consideration.

BACKGROUND: Gravity sewer rehabilitation activities are part of OCWS' efforts to proactively address aging infrastructure issues and will be funded using American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) dollars. OCWS has many miles of old vitrified clay pipe (VCP) in our gravity sewer collection system that is susceptible to groundwater infiltration, exfiltration, and root intrusion, which increases our risk of backups and sanitary sewer overflows. The rehabilitation method used to address this issue is cured-in-place pipe (CIPP), which is an interior liner that is installed without excavation. To date, we have lined approximately 25.6 miles of VCP in our system using CIPP (out of over 60 miles of VCP). Much of our unlined VCP is located in our Garniers Service Area (Ocean City/Wright Area).

Task Order 12 adds additional scope to the overall contract, specific for FY2024, as was originally intended for this phased maintenance contract. This scope includes mission critical work to address major issues of the existing sanitary sewer collection system infrastructure. This work will also extend the life of these gravity sewers and postures the County as best as possible to avoid and/or minimize emergency scenarios. The scope of work for Task Order 12 is based on a total budget of \$1,925,000.00 for FY2024 in accordance with the ARPA Implementation Plan.

This work is one important "piece of the puzzle" for better resiliency - by lining VCP and aging manholes, the amount of groundwater infiltrating into the sanitary sewer system will be reduced. This will lessen the risk of sewer spills at lift stations and overall during heavier rain events.
