

RESOLUTION NO. 13-168

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, INC., FOR CONTINUING CURED-IN-PLACE PIPE (CIPP) REHABILITATION SERVICES FOR A TERM OF ONE YEAR WITH FOUR ONE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTIONS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT WITH INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF AN AMOUNT UP TO \$374,000 FOR WORK UNDER THE CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE RENEWAL OPTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals for Continuing Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) Rehabilitation Service; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager or his designee has reviewed proposals submitted for the services; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Utilities Director recommends acceptance of the proposal submitted by Insituform Technologies, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has submitted a Sufficiency of Funds Certificate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DAYTONA BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The proposal submitted by Insituform Technologies, Inc., for Continuing Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) Rehabilitation Services for a term of one year with four one-year options to renew is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the CIPP Term Services Contract with Insituform Technologies, Inc., a copy in substantially final form being attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

SECTION 3. The expenditure of funds in an amount not to exceed \$374,000 for work under the referenced contract is hereby authorized.

SECTION 4. The City Manager is hereby authorized to exercise the renewal options under the above-referenced contract.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
