**AGREEMENT NO. 16-397-R
AMENDMENT NUMBER 2**

This Amendment Number 2 is made on the date of execution by the County and amends Agreement Number 16-397-R ("Main Agreement") dated June 24, 2016 between Columbia Telecommunications Corporation ("Contractor") and the County Board of Arlington County, Virginia ("County").

The County and the Contractor agree to amend the Main Agreement as follows:

1. ADD SECTION #50. COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY FOR THE CONTRACTORS TO THE CONTRACT AS FOLLOWS:

50. COVID-19 VACCINATION POLICY FOR CONTRACTORS

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the County has taken various steps to protect the welfare, health, safety and comfort of the workforce and public at large. As part of these steps, the County has implemented various requirements with respect to health and safety including policies with respect to social distancing, the use of face-coverings and vaccine mandates. All County Contractors, entering County owned, controlled, or leased facilities or facilities operated by a contractor if the services provided at that location are exclusive to Arlington County Government or contractors with public facing responsibilities must adopt these policies for implementation with their employees and subcontractors working on County contracts.

Contractors are required to obtain and maintain the COVID-19 vaccine status of employees or subcontractors, require any unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated employees to follow a weekly testing protocol established by the Contractor to submit to weekly testing, and provide any accommodations as required by law. Contractor should submit the certification of compliance to the Purchasing Agent at the time of contract execution and within five working days of the end of each quarter (see Exhibits D and E). In addition, all Contractor and subcontractor employees subject to the requirements of this section must also comply with the County COVID-19 masking and social distancing protocols, as signed at each County location.

It is recognized that the COVID-19 pandemic is an ongoing health crisis. As such, requirements with respect to health and safety, including vaccines and face-coverings may change over time. Contractors are expected to adhere to the County requirements as they evolve in response to the crisis.

This amendment is between Montgomery County, Maryland (the “County”) and Columbia Telecommunications Corporation dba CTC Technology & Energy (the “Contractor”).

Background

1. The parties entered into Contract No. 1035679 on July 1, 2016.
2. The present contract expiration date is June 30, 2022.
3. The purpose of this contract is Telecommunications Engineering Consulting Services.
4. The purpose of this Amendment is to extend the contract beyond the Term as authorized by the Contract Review Committee (CRC) in accordance with the Montgomery County Procurement Regulation Section 15.5.1.3.

Changes

1. The Contract Term is extended for one year through June 30, 2023. Before the current one-year term ends, the Director may (but is not required to) renew the Contract, if the Director determines that renewal is in the best interests of the County. The Director may exercise this option to renew for one additional one-year period. The Contractor’s satisfactory performance does not guarantee renewal of the contract term. The County has the option, upon providing ten (10) Calendar days written notice to the Contractor, to cancel the Contract with no cost, penalty, liability, or further obligation to the County for the cancellation of this Contract.

Effect

1. Existing contract terms remain in effect unless specifically changed by this amendment.
2. This amendment is entered into prior to the expiration of the Contract term.
3. This amendment is entered into on the date of signature by the Director, Office of Procurement.
4. No goods or services are to be provided pursuant to this amendment until the Director, Office of Procurement signs it.
