All fixtures, equipment and material used in the construction, operation, and maintenance of said facilities shall remain at all times the property of Gulf Power Company. The contract term as provided by Rate Schedule "OS (PART I/II)" shall be for an initial period of five (5) years for high pressure sodium street lighting, three (3) years if any high pressure sodium vapor (non-residential) or metal halide (non-residential) general area lighting is installed, and two (2) years if any high pressure sodium vapor (residential) general area lighting is installed, unless additional facilities required by the Company require a longer term. At the time Gulf Power Company begins to install any facilities applied for herein, this application becomes a contract for a term of
